PASTOR'S CORNER...

The Body of Christ

What the church is and what the church does is something for all of us to consider. Ephesians 4:12 has been a focus verse for me and for our congregation. Equipping the Saints speaks to me of the process of preparing someone for something: In this case, preparing the people for ministry work. The work of the "ministry" is a reminder to me that it isn't the work of Wes Stahl or any other leader: It is the work of the ministry, Christ's ministry. And for the building up of the Body, the church then is that body. It seems that many local congregations have little understanding of what the Body is; or more directly, Who the Body is. Many would like to include everyone under the umbrella of "the Body". The Body is composed of those who have been transformed by their commitment to Christ. They have been saved by repentance and transformed by commitment. Those who have been saved and are transformed or are being transformed will begin to show the results of their transformation. Those who have been transformed will have a built-in desire to see others saved and transformed. This will necessitate the believer learning the principles and doctrines to a level of being able to coherently instruct others. This is not to eliminate or nullify the need for the Holy Spirit's guidance but is instead a learning of how to seek and allow the Holy Spirit to use the God-given gifts and talents to glorify Christ through the obedience of worship and evangelism. The "Body" is believers; others may attend church and participate in service and ministry but a member of the Body of Christ will show the qualities of Christ in their life. May it be our goal to bring the "others" into the "Body".


