

PASTOR'S CORNER...

Numbers 23:19 says; God is not man, that he should lie, or a son of man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it? This verse speaks of God's Holiness and Righteousness and even His Omnipotence. I think we can take a little liberty here and say that God isn't made by man, nor does He take instruction from man, He doesn't get caught off guard, He doesn't change His mind and He never worries about an outcome. Paul wrote to the church in Philippi. He had been there, preached the Gospel, had many converts, and this church had taken it upon themselves to send supplies to care for Paul's needs, probably while he was imprisoned in Rome awaiting his eventual martyrdom. Paul had contentment even with all that was happening and tried to relay that to the Philippians. Christians are to become more and more like Jesus, Reborn, and Sanctified. Christians should be remade in His image. Mankind, even in the church, Christians try to make God in their image. They try to bring God down to earthly limitations in size and ability. Let me share with you that God, our Heavenly Father, Jesus, His Son, and the Holy Spirit is God in 3 persons, completely Holy and Righteous, completely without need or error. Completely without regret, fear, weakness, or any other infirmity known to mankind. God is at peace and has never been nervous or anxious. God does not deal in anxiety or fear, and He isn't interested in us living in it either. Our Faith and Trust are in our Savior and Lord. Our peace and Hope are in His return. Our strength is in His presence.
